The ideal candidate is someone who is practical, safety-minded, and committed to supporting both facility operations and patient care services.

Primary Responsibilities: Facility & Vehicle Maintenance

- Assist the maintenance worker with general upkeep tasks, including repairs to buildings and light fixtures, based on work orders.
- Perform minor building maintenance, such as wall painting and light installations.
- Conduct preventative checks and perform basic maintenance on medical vehicles and equipment.
- Ensure cleanliness, hygiene, and functional readiness of all vehicles, including ambulances.
- Take preventive safety measures to protect self, others, and property while working.
- Manage materials, tools, and equipment; report shortages and supply needs to the Manager Facility and Services.
- Maintain the exterior of the facility, including mowing lawns, trimming plants and shrubs, and pruning trees periodically.

Secondary Responsibilities: Ambulance Driving & Patient Transport

- Drive the ambulance safely during scheduled patient transport or emergency response situations.
- Assist medical staff with lifting and positioning patients, as well as basic care tasks during transport.
- Provide support in emergency situations, including performing Basic Life Support (BLS) when needed.
- Assist in the Emergency Room as requested, including setting up oxygen and helping manage patients.
- Communicate effectively with patients, staff, and emergency services.

Your profile:

- MBO level or an associate degree in a technical field, preferable basic construction, supplemented with an ambulance course and basic life support certificate;
- Good command (spoken and written) of the English language, Dutch is an asset;



- Valid driver's license.
- Physically fit, safety-conscious, and calm under pressure.
- Able to work independently and as part of a multidisciplinary team.
- High level of independence and eager to stay abreast of the latest developments in the function area.
